Update on eLitigation Training Training Commences on 14 August 2012

Please disregard our earlier email on the above subject, dated 1 August 2012, and refer to the below for updates.

The Electronic Filing System (EFS) will be replaced by the Integrated Electronic Litigation System (eLitigation) in phases commencing with the Supreme Court launch in October 2012.

To ensure that law firm users are equipped with the knowledge and skills to use the key modules in the system, a structured hands-on training programme has been designed for law firm administrators and users commencing on 14 August 2012. Focused on providing experiential teaching through effective use of case studies, the programme will cover the filing steps and functionalities of the system as well as key modules of eLitigation.

eLlitigation training has been duly accredited by the Singapore Institute of Legal Education (SILE) with Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points. Lawyers admitted to the Singapore Bar on or after 2 January 2007 are encouraged to register for the sessions to meet their yearly CPD requirements. The training programme is structured as follows:

PACKAGE A1 : User Module - full day Important: This basic module is a pre-requisite for packages B1 to B3 of this programme. PACKAGE A2 : Admin Module PACKAGE B1 : Probate Module PACKAGE B2 : Criminal Module PACKAGE B3 : Family Module
